Event Summary

The AI & Big Data Expo 2024, held at the RAI Convention Centre in Amsterdam on October 1-2, brought together thousands of attendees from around the globe to explore the latest advancements in artificial intelligence and data technologies. As one of Europe's largest AI and data science conferences, the two - day event featured expert panels, interactive exhibits, and discussions on critical issues shaping the future of AI.

With a focus on ethical AI practices and the intersection of governance and innovation, the Expo provided a platform for global thought leaders, policymakers, and industry professionals to collaborate on addressing the challenges and opportunities of the rapidly evolving AI landscape.

RegulatingAl's Impact

Regulating AI played a significant role at the AI & Big Data Expo 2024, contributing to pivotal conversations and thought leadership on ethical AI and regulatory compliance. Sanjay Puri, Founder and President of Regulating AI, was a featured speaker on two key panels. The first, *Ethical Considerations in Generative AI and Data Science*, explored the complexities of creating responsible AI systems, with Puri emphasizing the critical need for global governance standards. The second, *Navigating the EU AI Act*, offered insights into aligning innovation with regulatory requirements, shedding light on strategies for compliance within the EU's evolving framework.

RegulatingAI further amplified its impact by hosting live podcasts directly from the event floor. These engaging discussions, streamed on the RegulatingAI Podcast YouTube channel, featured prominent industry experts such as *Samwel Magesa*, Chairman of MSA Africa; Jeannette Gorzala, CEO of Act. AI.Now; *Kunal Anand*, Chief Technology & AI Officer of F5; *Nenad Mijatovic*, Director of Data Science & AI at Alstom and RegulatingAI Expert, to name a few. Through these contributions, RegulatingAI demonstrated its commitment to advancing responsible AI innovation and fostering global dialogue on the future of AI.




